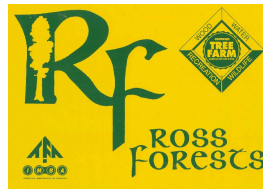

Members of Sugar Camp Hollow International Mountain Bike Club are permitted to use trails and roads on Ross Forests Partnership property in Hardin County Tennessee subject to the following terms:

1. Sign the liability waiver on the other side.
2. No dues are charged but members are asked to contribute to trail maintenance.
3. Hunting clubs have hunting leases on the property and have priority use so bicyclists should not ride where hunters are known to be present during hunting seasons.
4. Helmets should be worn at all times.
5. Members who have cell phones should carry them on the rides.
6. Avoid riding near logging activities.
7. Report any hazardous conditions to club officer and/or owners of Ross Forests property.
8. Avoid leaving litter on the ground. Take out what you bring in.
9. Permission to use trails and membership may be terminated by club officers and owners of Ross Forests at any time.
10. Ride only on established roads and trails.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any way in **Sugar Camp Hollow International Mountain Bike Club** ("Club") sponsored Bicycling Activities ("Activity") and use of trails and roads on **Ross Forests Partnership** property, I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I understand the nature of Bicycling Activities and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activity. I further agree and warrant that if at any time I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.

2. Fully understand that: (a) bicycling activities involve risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis, and death ("Risks"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or the negligence of the "Releasees" named below; (c) there may be other Risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at the time; and I fully accept and assume all such Risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I incur as a result of my participation or that of the minor in the Activity.

3. Hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Club or Ross Forests Partnership, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, members, volunteers, and employees,

other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place including the owners and members of Ross Forests Partnership, (each considered one of the "Releasees" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "Releasees" or otherwise including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release and waiver of liability, assumption of Risk, and indemnity agreement I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim. I have read this agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect. further, I agree to wear a helmet and obey all traffic signs, signals and regulations. I also agree to abide by the guidelines presented by the Activity leader. MINOR RELEASE: I, the Minor's parent and/or legal guardian, understand the nature of bicycling activities and the Minor's experience and capabilities and believe the Minor to be qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in

such Activity. I hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue, and agree to indemnify and save and hold harmless each of the Releasees from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on the Minor's account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations and further agree that if, despite this release, I, the Minor, or anyone on the Minor's behalf makes a claim against any of the Releasees named above, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss liability, damage, or cost any may incur as the result of any such claim.
